7. MEDIA

The Media have been advised that interviews will take place at the conclusion of training and/or Competition session but if any athlete has concluded their training earlier then via the GA Competition Manager and GA Media Officer interview can be organised earlier with the approval of the Country coach.

8. AYOF VILLAGE

All International delegations and Australian Athletes/Coaches will be accommodated at the University of Sydney.

Village:

University of Sydney

Teams will be housed at one of the following colleges within the University:

- Sydney University Village
- Women's College

Dining Hall:

Dining Hall hours will be posted at the Village. Allowances have been made to suit the Training and Competition Schedules.

Village Services Centre:

The Village Services Centre will be at the village with daily information and updates. The Centre will generally be open every day from 0700 – 2200. Two resident Village Duty Managers will be located at the Village for after hour emergencies.

Medical Services:

There will be first aid kits available 24 hours at the Village Services Centre. Should further treatment be required, the information desk will be able to assist with organising medical appointments.

9. MEDICAL SERVICES

Medical Personnel will be present for both training and competition sessions.

Ice will be made available during all training and competition sessions.

10. DRUG TESTING

Drug tests may be conducted at the 2007 Australian Youth Olympic Festival in accordance with International Regulation. Coaches need to be aware that no prior warning is given before Australian Sports Anti-doping Authority (ASADA) Officials arrive and make their random selections for the tests. Should any athletes be selected to provide a test sample, please co-operate with the ASADA Officials.

11. AIRPORT TRANSFERS

All Delegation members will be met upon their arrival at Sydney airport and transferred to the Village. Any changes to departure details should be notified upon arrival to Village Information Desk.

Following check-out from the Village, all delegation members will be transferred to Sydney airport, to catch their departing flights.

Judges will also be met at Sydney Airport and transferred to the Ibis Hotel. Following check-out from the Ibis, judges will be transferred back to Sydney airport.

12. TRANSPORT

A dedicated transport schedule has been organised for all gymnastics training and competition sessions.

The Transport Schedule will be posted at the Information Desk at the village.

13. AUSTRALIAN OFFICIALS

All interstate funded technical officials will be accommodated at the Ibis Hotel. Per Diems will be issued where venue meals are not available to each Official for Lunch and/or Dinner.

For Sydney based Officials, car parking will be available at the southern end of the venue.

14. ACCREDITATIONS

Accreditations for Athletes and Officials staying at the village will be issued on arrival at the Village with an information package.

Australian Officials will collect their accreditations and packages at the Competition Office at the competition venue.

15. OPENING CEREMONY

The AYOF Opening Ceremony will take place on Wednesday, 17 January 2007 from 18.00 – 20.00 at the Sydney Entertainment Centre.

Prior to the Opening Ceremony a Welcome Reception will be held at Tumbalong Park from 4:30pm and the flag bearers for each nation will be announced and the ambassadors for each sport will be introduced.

The Opening Ceremony celebrates the official opening of the AYOF. It will feature live entertainment and the essential elements of an Olympic Opening Ceremony including an athletes parade, athlete and officials oath, and of course the lighting of the Flame.

The AYOF Opening Ceremony will be one of the highlights of the Festival not to be missed.

A bus shuttle will operate from each of the Village sites to transport athletes and team officials to the Welcome Reception and then transferred to the Opening Ceremony. Parading athletes and team officials will be sorted by delegation for the official parade into the Ceremony. Upon completion of the Opening Ceremony bus shuttles will return all athletes and team officials to their respective Village sites.

16. DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM

A series of Drug Education Presentations will be conducted as part of the Australian Youth Olympic Festival.

The Drug Education presentations feature prominent Australian Olympic Athletes who present on the following topics:

- the moral, ethical, social and physical reasons for not taking performance enhancing and/or recreational drugs;
- relevant anti doping issues (such as the use of supplements and inadvertent doping) and the introduction of key agencies such as ASADA;
- the values of competing drug free and the AOC ASPIRE message;
- creating an awareness amongst young aspiring athletes of the wide-spread presence of banned drugs and of the risks and penalties associated with their use.

It is compulsory for all Australian athletes to attend one of the drug education presentations. International athletes are invited to attend a drug education presentation.
