MEN

The Australian Championships are governed by the 2006 FIG Code of Points and the Gymnastics Australia Men's National Program Rules.

RHYTHMIC

The Australian Championships are governed by the 2005 - 2008 FIG Code of Points for the International Stream competitors and the National Levels Competition will be governed by the National Program Manual 2006-2008

- b) Each gymnast has been issued with a competition number. Number must be worn by each gymnast during competition with the exception of Rhythmic.
- c) Inquiries

Women

International Division: Queries on Start Values and routine scores should be directed to the Superior Jury.

National Levels: There will be NO INQUIRIES on the final score.

Start Value queries will be accepted using the appropriate proforma (available during the competition). There will be no cost attached to these SV queries.

Men

The National SMC is currently reviewing the protest / inquiry procedure for national events with a view to closer alignment with the 2006 Code of Points. The procedure to be applied at the 2006 National Championships will be explained at the MAG Orientation Meeting.

Rhythmic

- f) Music: On arrival at the competition venue. **Please hand in two (2) sets competition CD's** to the Music Co-ordinator. All CD's are to be received by the Music Co-ordinator no later than the completion of the gymnast's allocated podium training. Only one piece of music per CD is permitted.

The recording must bear the following information on the case **and** on the actual CD.

- ◆ Name and number of gymnast
- ◆ State
- ◆ Symbol representing the Apparatus (RHYTHMIC Only)
- ◆ Duration of music for the exercise
- ◆ The name of the composer and of the music used.

NB: There will be an Audio Cassette player available – however where possible we encourage participants to provide all music on CD

- g) Medals will be awarded as per technical regulations (see attached)
- h) No Video personnel will be allowed on the competition floor during competitions or competition warm ups with the exception of the official GA video personnel.
- i) Only one Medical personnel per State will be allowed on the Competition Floor.

8. Rhythmic Apparatus Measurements

Juniors and Seniors apparatus will be measured at official podium training.

Levels and Stages apparatus will not be measured at podium training, although the measuring table will be set up for Coaches/gymnasts to check their apparatus.

A control (measuring) may take place at the end of an exercise at the request of the Jury if the apparatus dimensions appear questionable.

9. Warm-up:

Ice will be available during training and competition. Water will be available for coaches and gymnasts during training sessions and competitions.



General Information

1. Championship Office:

The Championship Office will be positioned at the foot of the Stairs on Competition Level.

State Pigeon Holes will be located outside the Championship Office.

Only the Head of Delegation from each State may collect all information and results.

2. Accreditation:

There will be formal accreditation cards issued for all personnel and competitors at this event.

Accreditation is to be collected from the Championship Office. Please ensure these are collected prior to your first training session.

Gymnasts, coaches, judges and officials not participating in a session are requested to assist by remaining in the spectator area when they are not directly participating.

3. Music:

The Competition sound system will be available at the training sessions from Sunday 14th May.

4. Delegation seating at the Competition Venue:

Seating has been made available for all competition gymnasts, officials, judges, and personnel when not involved on the floor.

5. Medical Services:

During Competition and training, a doctor and/or physiotherapist will be in attendance.

6. Medicare Numbers

All Medicare numbers should have been entered on Imis at the time of Definitive Entries. These numbers will be held by the medical personnel so that treatment during the competition can be bulk billed. This has been organised to help keep medical costs to a minimum but be able to support our medical personnel working at the event.

7. March On – Gymnasts and Judges:

Gymnasts will march on in State Groups for competition. Tracksuits will be appropriate dress. The gymnasts & judges marshalling area will be at the southern end of the venue.

8. Drug Testing

“Drug Tests” may be conducted at these Championships either during training and/or competition.

Team Managers/Heads of Delegations and coaches need to be aware that no prior warning is given before ASDA Officials arrive and make their random selections for the testing. Should your gymnasts be selected please co-operate with the ASDA Officials. ASDA “Drug Test” procedures are attached.

Use of Therapeutic Use Exemptions Form is attached.

9. Technical and Judges Meetings:

A list of the various Technical and Judges’ meetings to take place during the Championships is included in this Workplan. Please ensure all personnel involved in these meetings are aware of the details.



10. Function

In a change from last year, the function will be held at the Novotel Hotel. Numbers have been limited to 300 and tickets have been allocated to states prior to the Championships.

Entry is by ticket only.

The evening has been programmed to be no longer than 2 hours in duration. It is requested that delegations do not depart before the conclusion of the evening.

There will be allocated seating by State. A seating plan will be given to each State at the orientation meeting for Women. Men's and Rhythmic Team Managers must liaise with the Women's Team Manager for seating arrangements within your State.

It is recommended that States arrive early so that everyone can be seated by 7.15pm for an official start at 7.30pm.

The function centre is in walking distance from the Sports Centre.

It is recommended that bus drivers drop off state delegations at the front of the venue and then park at the Sports Centre. Free parking is not available at the function centre.



11. Parking

Parking has been arranged for delegations throughout the event. This will be in the car park behind the Sports Centre.

12. Athlete/Official Entrance.

Sydney Olympic Park Sports Centre is a ticketed venue, which means that a ticket is required to enter the venue. Therefore, all accredited Athletes, Officials and Competition Personnel will be required to enter via the reception door at the front of the venue.

This will apply during competition and training.



13. Event Photographer

There will be an official event photographer present at all sessions. Photos taken from the event will be on display at the event for purchase and displayed on the Photographer's official web site for purchase after the event.

Drug Testing Procedure

These procedures are written for the Head of Delegation/Coach to assist them in advising the gymnasts of the procedure.

1. After the competition or during training, the gymnast will be notified by an ASADA official that they have been selected for a drug test.
2. The gymnast should immediately advise their Coach/Manager.
3. The ASADA Official or appointed chaperone will accompany the gymnast to the Drug Control Waiting Room where they will be provided with sealed drinks. The gymnast is entitled to have their Coach/Manager or selected representative present.
4. When they are ready to provide a sample, the gymnast will be asked to select a sample collection container.
5. When they have provided the required amount of urine, they return to the Drug Control Room. Only the gymnast should handle the sample.
6. The gymnasts will be asked to select a pair of security containers.
7. The gymnasts should check the seals before opening the container.
8. The gymnast will then be asked to pour the sample into A and B Bottles.
9. The kit is then resealed with new security seals.
10. The Drug Control Official checks the pH and Specific Gravity of the sample. These both indicate the suitability of the sample for testing.
11. The Drug Control Official records the sample and seal numbers on Drug testing form. The gymnast will be asked to provide the contact information and declare medications that they have used in the previous week.
12. The Drug Control Official will ask the gymnast and their representative to check all information on the Drug Testing Form and if satisfied, sign the form. The drug Control Official will also check and sign the form.

Trans Tasman Challenge - MAG National Championships

Introduction

This document contains the rules set by Gymnastics Australia to formalise the Trans Tasman Challenge to be conducted during the MAG National Championships and will allow for the variations of the entry numbers from year to year.

Level Categories

The Trans Tasman Challenge will be held at each level of the MAG discipline where New Zealand has entered a Team and where Australia has appropriate entries to form a Team.

Team Sizes

Team sizes will be based on the principle of matching the number of gymnasts in each division entered by New Zealand, up to a maximum of six per country. A team in a division may include anywhere from 1 to 6 gymnasts, by applying this matching principle.

Team selection

Australian Team to be selected considering the following:

1. MAG – top scores from the first round of competition with a maximum of 1 per state where this provides for the maximum team size of six. Where there are less than 6 states with gymnasts in the level of competition a second gymnast is to be drawn per state according to AA scores achieved until the maximum team size of six is met.
2. Team size to be determined based on the numbers of available gymnasts allowable in competition rules.
3. Mutual agreement with New Zealand Technical Committee / Australian National SMC

New Zealand Team to consist of the number of NZ gymnasts eligible for each level / division (selected by the NZ Technical Committee) up to a maximum team size of six gymnasts per level / division (subject to acceptance of entries by competition organisers).

Competition format

MAG – Gymnasts are to remain with their State teams for the rotations but the members of the Australian Team at each level to be announced prior to the start of the competition and to be acknowledged at the presentation of medals and the Trans Tasman perpetual trophy.

Awards

Team

For each level / division at the MAG National Championships where New Zealand have entered a team, the All Around scores over both rounds of competition for ALL members of each team will be aggregated.

In each level / division contested, the team with the highest aggregated score will be presented with gold medals, and the team with the second highest aggregated score will be presented with silver medals.

Perpetual Trophy

A Trans Tasman Trophy will be awarded to the successful country based on the following:

The total team score in each level of competition will be aggregated to give a country total. The country with the highest score shall be awarded the Trans Tasman trophy for the MAG discipline.

All Around and Apparatus

There will be no individual awards presented for All Around or Apparatus.

Tie Breaking rules

In the event of a tie in the team competition for a level / division, the following principles will be applied in order to break the tie:

- the team with the highest individual All Around score (over two rounds)
- the team with the highest individual single round All Around score
- the team with the highest individual Apparatus score from the second round of competition.

In the event of a tie in the overall competition for Trans Tasman Perpetual Trophy, the following principles will be applied in order to break the tie:

- the country with the highest aggregate team score in a level or division
- the country with the highest individual All Around score (over two rounds)
- the country with the highest individual single round All Around score
